










+ additional ERC grantee from Transferred Funds



Good news on this 35th anniversary of the Restoration of Independence in Lithuania! A new ERC project from a Lithuanian researcher can now go ahead, as she was able to secure alternative EU funding for her ERC Consolidator Grant.

How is this possible? The transfer between cohesion policy funds and Horizon Europe is one of the new possibilities available in the 2021-2027 programming period in the context of synergies between EU funding sources. These transfers give an opportunity to EU countries to strengthen participation in Horizon Europe and to improve the success rate of their applicants. EU countries may request the transfer of up to 5% of their resources from the European Regional Development Fund. And Lithuania used this option.

The Lithuanian government has decided to use this financial transfer mechanism to support its researchers applying for ERC grants. The transfer is carried out by redirecting part of the ERDF funds to finance ERC research projects that were evaluated as excellent during ERC evaluation but that did not receive funding due to a limited budget (so-called unfunded As). For the two-year programme (2024 and 2025), Lithuania has allocated some €18 million in this way, enabling among others the funding of additional ERC grants.

Thanks to this initiative, Lithuanian neuroscientist Urtė Neniškytė from Vilniaus universitetas / Vilnius University's Life Sciences Center will now be able to conduct research that could help treat brain network disorders. Her team will investigate how the glycocalyx - a type of identifier that the body uses to distinguish between its own healthy cells and diseased cells - contributes to how the brain works as well as to diseases of the brain.


